



Jun-nori	A popular Korean board game family and friends. It is typically played by two teams.
	A memorial service to worship and express gratitude to family angor Korean holidays.
서하 보 많이 받으서요 Sehae bok nani baduSeyo [se-hae bok ma-ni ba-du-se-yo]	Literally translated as "May you have a lot of New Year's fortune (blessing)." This is a common greeting for the new year, equivalent to "Happy New Year."




- 1. Cut along black solid lines.
- Glue everything into a bowl, in the order of Broth - Tteok - Mandoo garnish with Scallion to come last.


Tip: Choose between meat and mushroom, or use both!










Let's Make a Paper Bokjumoni 복주머니 만들기




1. Cut a piece of paper into a square, then crease into thirds.




2. Fold both sides of the paper inward to meet each crease.




3. Fold down the top corners.




4. Fold the bottom half up to the top corners.




5. Fold along the dotted line on the left, then unfold to create a triangular crease. Repeat this step on the right.




6. Flip the paper over and fold along both creases in the opposite direction, to create stronger creases.



7. Turn the paper around so it is facing front. You should see diagonal creases now.




8. Pinch the triangle shapes on both sides (where you see X marks) and gently push them inward. The front portion of the paper should lift up.



9. This is how it should look now. Press the sides down to make this shape.

Decorate them and use them!



10. Fold the top over.
